**Field of Membership Expansions Granted**

1) The Division of Credit Unions has granted the request of Telcomm Credit Union (TCU), located in Springfield, Missouri, to expand their field of membership to include all those who reside or work in Lawrence County, Missouri, whose estimated population is 37,757 (U.S. Census Bureau, 2008 estimate).

TCU has chosen the binding membership designation of a credit union serving a geographic area pursuant to RSMo 370.080(2).

The most recent supervisory examination report has been reviewed.

The Division of Credit Unions has reviewed the member data report.

The most recent National Credit Union Administration report shows that the credit union is well capitalized.

The Division of Credit Unions has determined that Greene County is the credit union's headquartered county and that Lawrence County is contiguous to Greene County.

The application was received on November 30, 2009 and reported on the Division's electronic bulletin dated December 3, 2009.

No comments were received during the ten business day comment period.

2) The Division of Credit Unions has granted the request of Holy Rosary Credit Union (HRCU), located in Kansas City, Missouri, to expand their field of membership to include employees of Paris Brothers, Inc., the employees of Avenue Pawn and the members and leaders of Boy Scout Troop 80, all of Kansas City, Missouri. The total of this group is approximately 148 individuals.

HRCU has chosen the binding membership designation of a credit union serving common occupations, associations or employers, pursuant to RSMo 370.080 (2).

The most recent supervisory examination report has been reviewed.

The credit union's financial condition has been reviewed.

The Director has reviewed the member data report.

The most recent National Credit Union Administration report shows that the credit union is well capitalized.

The Director has determined that the employer groups requested are fewer than three thousand in number.

The application was received on December 7, 2009 and reported on the Division's electronic bulletin dated December 9, 2009.
